What do the funded hours cover?

“Government funding is to deliver your 30 hours of childcare support. It does not cover additional hours, activities or extra costs, such as meals. Your provider should provide invoices and receipts that are clear, transparent and itemised to see you have received your child’s free entitlements and understand any fees for additional hours or services.

You may have to pay for, or provide your own:

- meals
- other consumables, like nappies
- additional hours
- additional services or activities

However, charges for consumables or additional hours should not be made a condition of accessing a free place.

You should not be charged:

- a top-up fee
- a non-refundable registration fee

You may wish to speak to your local authority or your provider about any additional charges on top of the funded childcare hours, including any alternative options they offer.”

“For every £8 you pay into this account, the government will pay in £2. You can get up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare. This goes up to £1,000 every 3 months if a child is disabled (up to £4,000 a year).”

All fees and charges will be reviewed in April 2026, or with a month's notice.
